





#### Christ In Me For Them...

Everything Christ does **in** me is intended to affect everyone Christ puts **around** me.



## Cultivating a Spiritually Transformed Social Life...

- Understand the wholeness you have in Christ.
  - ▶ We **died** with Christ.
  - ▶ We **live** in Christ.
    - He is our life <u>now</u>.
    - He is our life **forever**.
- Leave behind the <u>habits</u> you had before Christ.
  - ▶ What we put to death...
    - Sins that destroy us.
    - Is my **body** consecrated to God?
    - Is my **mind** clean before God?

- Are my **desires** controlled by God?
- Is my **heart** content in God?
- Sins that damage others.
  - Do I harbor bitterness?
  - Am I **quick** to anger?
  - Do I have **hostility** toward anyone?
  - Do I ever speak <u>negatively</u> about anyone?
  - Are my words ever <u>offensive</u> to others?
  - Do I ever <u>misrepresent</u> the truth?
- ▶ Why we put them to death...
  - Because they bring God's <u>judgment</u>.
  - Because they betray God's <u>salvation</u>.

### ■ Live in the <u>character</u> you received from Christ.

- We extend the **grace** of Christ to others.
  - Do I show great mercy to others?
  - Does my **kindness** spur others toward Christ?
  - Am I **selfless** in my relationships with others?
  - Do I relate to others gently?
  - Am I <u>patient</u> with others?
  - Do I **endure** hardship in relationships with others?
  - Do I **forgive** others completely?
  - Does genuine <u>love</u> permeate my relationships with others?
- We promote the **peace** of Christ among others.
- We share the **Word** of Christ with others.
- We honor the Name of Christ before others.
  - Wives: Love submissively.
  - Husbands: Love sacrificially.
  - Children: **Obey** completely.
  - Parents: **Encourage** continually.
  - Employees: Work wholeheartedly.
  - Employers: Lead **humbly**.


- Ask God to empower you to leave behind the habits of the sinful nature and enable you to live in the character of Christ regarding these facets of your relationships with others this week.
- Commit or recommit your life to a small group where you can glorify Christ through your relationships with others.
